Our Star Angel Pinot noir comes from the Santa Rita Hills AVA. The cool ocean breeze from the nearby Pacific Ocean creates exceptionally rich and aromatic wine grapes, producing some of California's most exiting Pinot Noirs

This elegant Pinot Noir has a beautiful dark ruby color with a harmonious balance of lively fruit like blueberries, plum skins and pomegranate with hints of oak and red tea.

A wine appealing in the palate for its bright and juicy fruit flavours with a smooth texture and spice notes. A very expressive Pinot Noir with a superb medium body and soft tannins that finish with elegance and drive.

Santa Rita Hills, California (La Encantada & John Sebastiano vineyards)

Oak Aging:

For 12 months in French oak barrels.

About 6 tons per hectare (3.5 tons per acre)

Pinot Noir 100 %

693 cases (12x750ml)

14,5 %
